




INVOLVEMENT IN THE MEDIATION PROCESS

- This saw the country experience relatively peaceful elections in 2013 and 2017 despite the Presidential Runoff
- This proactive role was key to returning stability to the country. It is with this same spirit that Mkenya Daima 2022 aspires to have a peaceful election and smooth transition.

The 3 'wajibus' are:






POLITICAL PILLAR - LEADERSHIP AND GOVERNANCE


